






Primary health care (PHC) has been a priority for health care reform. The organization and provision of PMD services is based on the principles:

- Availability
- Security
- Effectiveness
- Economic efficiency
- Non-discrimination
- Human orientation



The function of purchasing qualitative and safe medical services needed by patients is performed by the National Health Service of Ukraine (NHSU)



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- In the logistics of primary care financing reform, replace the "money follows the patient" principle with "money follows services".
